



LIBBY FAQ



Q: WHAT IS LIBBY?

A: Libby by OverDrive is a free app where you can borrow eBooks only (**not eAudiobooks**) from your public library. You need your library card and PIN.



Q: I HAVE A BUCKS COUNTY LIBRARY CARD, CAN I USE LIBBY?

A: Libby is not a county-wide service; it is funded by residents' taxpayer dollars in participating areas. Therefore, only the libraries that subscribe to and participate with Libby can offer access to the library users in their service areas. For library users in other service areas, we recommend accessing Libby from POWER Library or Free Library of Philadelphia.



Q: WHICH LIBRARIES PARTICIPATE WITH LIBBY?

A: Free Library of Northampton Township, Free Library of New Hope & Solebury, Margaret R. Grundy Memorial Library, Pipersville Free Library, Southampton Free Library, Township Library of Lower Southampton, Warminster Township Free Library, and Morrisville Public Library – have formed the Community Library e-Cooperative (CLE) of Bucks County.



Q: I LIVE IN ONE OF THE ABOVE SERVICES AREAS, BUT RECEIVED MY CARD AT A DIFFERENT LIBRARY. CAN I GET LIBBY?

A: Yes, you can have your home library changed to match your address by visiting that library in person and presenting your proof of residency.



Q: ARE NEWTOWN RESIDENTS ABLE TO ACCESS LIBBY?

A: No. Unfortunately, Newtown residents are not part of one of the above service areas that participate with Libby. We recommend accessing Libby from POWER Library or Free Library of Phila.



Q: CAN I GET LIBBY EBOOKS ON A KINDLE EREADER (Paperwhite)?

A: Yes! There is a separate library instruction sheet on how to get Kindle eReader eBooks from Libby. You will need your Amazon account log in. Kindle Fire tablets are also compatible with Libby. A Reference Librarian can assist if needed.



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
